Spiritual evolution means evolution from Ignorance to Knowledge

Sense Mind

The data of the senses is our first means of emerging from ignorance

Our senses constantly deceive us

Sense knowledge is blind to content

Sense data has to be interpreted by the reason in order to be useful

Limitations of the mixed reason

- The data from the senses is always inadequate to know reality
- When reason bases itself on sense data, it is prone to serious errors.
- Mixed reason often mistakes appearances for reality, form for content
- Withdrawing from the senses, mixed reason becomes pure reason

Pure Reason

- Even the pure reason is an instrument of Ignorance, not Knowledge
- It divides reality into small parts.
- It cannot know the whole.
- It cannot know the essential truth.
- There is Truth in every mental viewpoint
- Reason can argue any side of a truth as valid
- Can we conceive and concede that those we vehemently disagree with are also right?

Faith in Mind

- Reliance on mind breeds many types of Superstition
- First rule of Psychic Education is to shift reliance from the mind's externalized way of seeing things
- Our first response to events should be consecration not understanding

Vedantic Knowledge

Withdrawing from thought, reason becomes intuition

Charlotte sees that Darcy is in love

Eliza refrains from exposing Darcy to Jane

Constitutional Ignorance

- We are ignorant of the real constitution of our being -- Mental, Vital, Physical and Spiritual
- Each part is ignorant of the others and acts independently
- We give inordinate value to physical sensations and perceptions
- We base our reason on our vital preference
- We mistake our thoughts for reality of our being
- All the parts of our being are at war with one another

Psychological Ignorance

- We are ignorant of the depths of our being Subconscient, Subliminal, Superconscient, Circumconscient, Psychic
- We lack of self-awareness
- We do not see and know ourselves the way others see us
- To know ourselves the way others know us is a major step from Ignorance to Knowledge
- We value ourselves as society values us rather than based on our highest spiritual potential

Egoistic Ignorance

- Reason is dominated by Ego
- Egoistic Ignorance is ignorance of other's point of view
- Taking others' point of view overcomes it

Temporal Ignorance

We are lost in the moment

We repeat past follies over and over

We are unconscious of the future

We mistake the effect for cause

Cosmic Ignorance

Man's soul seeks to discover the Infinite and express it in finite life

Reason cannot know the Infinite

We must withdraw faith in the mind's externalized way of seeing.

Original Ignorance

The secret of knowledge is it is the light of self-existence

God is not merely an impersonal Truth. It is a Being

Original Ignorance is ignorance of the Integral Brahman
